

Three Steps to a New Facility for the Middle School and Upper School

(reprinted from February 8, 2007 E-Marker)

1. WHAT

- RHSM continues to pursue the purchase 13.2 acres of land (west of the McCarthy Campus)
- The land would be the future location of a new facility for our middle and upper school students.
- The school can buy the land from Mt. Olivet Cemetery only after the city's rezoning process is finalized.

2. HOW

RHSM's application for rezoning will be approved only after **(1)** RHSM submits an acceptable building footprint to the city; **and (2)** a federal clause attached to Mt. Olivet's deed has been amended.

3. WHEN

- A building footprint designed by EHDD Architecture has to be filed with the city before the land is purchased.
- The trustees' Mt. Olivet Committee continues to work with federal agencies and Utah's Congressional delegation to draft a bill amending the cemetery's reversionary clause to include educational and recreational use. Passage of this bill by the U.S. Congress could take anywhere from a month to a year or more.
- When the above conditions are met the City Planning Department will give final approval to the school's application for rezoning and RHSM will be free to purchase the property.
